CAIO Circle Hosts Virtual Roundtable on Future-Ready AI Workplace Policies

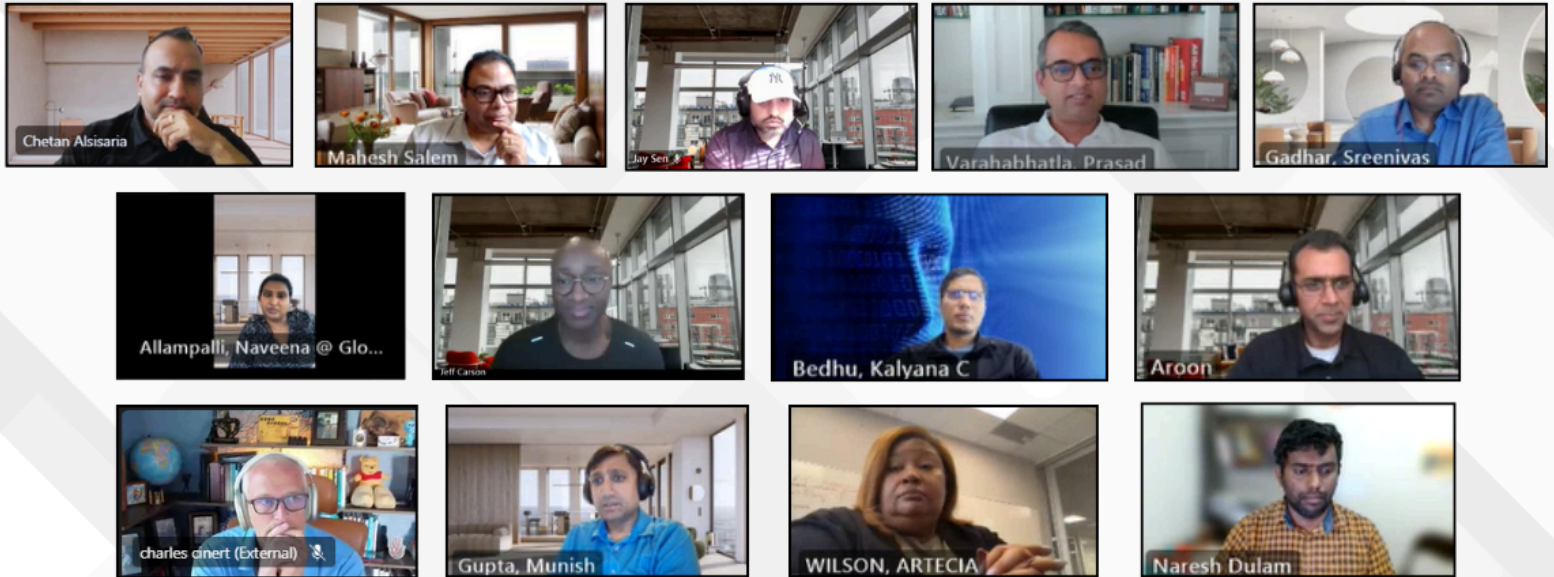
